

Barrett in Top Form at Masters Track and Field

A number of veteran athletes from Galway competed strongly in the Irish Masters Track and Field in Tullamore - Pat Finn from Aughrim winning bronze in the javelin and Mary Barrett (Loughrea AC) winning a haul of 4 gold (high jump 1.30, long jump 3.91, shot putt 9.21, discus 28.93 PB) and 1 silver (javelin 23.21).

Also in action, Pat Hannon (Loughrea AC) finished in 4th place in the 800m and in the high jump. Hannon was fresh from his exploits in the European Masters Track and Field in Poland in at the end of July where he has a superb string of results in the O45 800m, running 2.12.59 to qualify for the semi-final and running 2.10.12 in the semi-final to narrowly miss out on making the final.
